LEARNING TOPICS

Ranganna 1/2

Ranganna 1 / 2 are learning about *Myself and My Family* this term. They will develop their understanding about the parts of the body, the senses, their importance as people and about the special people in their families.

Rang 3

Children in Rang 3 are finding out about different kind of schools in this country and in other countries through the topic *We Like School!* A survey will be sent out to grandparents next week as part of their research into schools long ago.
